I. Science, She Says! Award

The Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation organizes the *Science, She Says! Award* to recognize an outstanding junior Italian female scientist who has remarkably contributed to the advancement of science and technology, while performing in one of the five regions (Africa and the Middle East, Asia and the Pacific, Europe, Central and South America and the Caribbean, North America).

One candidate should be selected from every region taking into account they have worked there in the last 4 years. As eligibility criteria, candidates should prove contribution to the advancement of bilateral scientific cooperation in any field, should be a resident in the country where she is nominated at least since January 1st, 2019 and their application should be submitted by an eminent scientist who is holding a leading position in a Scientific Academy, University, Research Institute or S&T Department of the Government of Hungary.

II. Italian Bilateral Scientific Cooperation Award

The Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation established the *Italian Bilateral Scientific Cooperation Award* to recognize the work of an Italian experienced scientist who has remarkably contributed to the advancement of science and technology (S&T) while performing his/her research abroad, thus improving Italy's S&T relations with foreign countries and International Organizations.

Applications are welcome if nominees are residents of the country where they are nominated for the award at least since January 1st, 2019, they have 3-7 years of experience since completion of their Ph.D. degree, and are no older than 35 years at the time of publication of this notice.

III. EU-FORA – The European Food Risk Assessment Fellowship Programme

The programme keeps evolving based on seven years of experience, the implementation of 94 work programmes, and the participation of more than 70 supervisors from 43 organisations in 18 different EU Member States and the UK and over 100 fellows that now constitute the EU-FORA Alumni. The fellowship programme aims to increase the pool of food safety risk assessment experts available in Europe and stimulate the involvement of Member States in risk assessment work, all with the ultimate objective of building a common EU culture for risk assessment.

Fellow sending organisation and hosting site must apply as a consortium. Following a call for proposals, EFSA will rank the applications received based on their quality and relevance, as well as on the suitability of the identified fellow. Awarded consortia will sign a Grant Agreement with EFSA, the contribution of which is meant to support the costs incurred by both organisations. The fellowship lasts for 12 months.
